BOOK SALE WAS A SUCCESS!!!

Our first book sale was a huge success. We had over 4,000 books/DVD/Audio Books donated to sell. We sold 1,225 books and all the DVDs (644).

Our sale also directly benefited the library's circulation. We donated 99 current books from the book sale to put into circulation (approx. \$2,475 realized in savings). All remaining books will be sold or donated to another charitable organization.

The total amount raised at the book sale was \$1,753.27!!



Book Sale by the numbers:

160 volunteer hours over 6 days (including sale days and set-up/take down days)

140 "customers" over the 3 days

15 new members signed up during the sale.
